I would like to congratulate bot Cllr John Mathews and Cllr Richard Edgell on there their recent election success. Both Councillors have worked hard for our area and I am pleased they will continue to assist this Council.

As you may know from the 5th of June next Monday the Council will only collect Green Bin waste if the resident has contracted with the council to collect by paying £36.00. Food waste should not be put in the green bin from the 5th of June. For those who have done so earlier ie placed food wast in currently this will be collected as normal. We have been collecting 38000 green waste bins 9,000 custormers have now paid the new charge and we would estimate this to go to around 12,000 in the not too distant future. Incidentally my Executive visited Tawnton Deane Borough Council a few days ago and they are charging £50.00 per annum for green waste collection.

North Devon Council have an agenda item on Monday 5th June to allocate £18,310 of capital funds to Tawstock Parish Council towards the cost of provision and enhancement of open space at Tower View, to be funded form \$106 public open space funds.

Further that the Executive allocates £22,233.38 as a one off revenue payment to Tawstock Parish Council towards the future maintenance of Tower View public open space and play area, to be funded form the public open space revenue funds.

This has to be agreed by the Executive on the 5th June and then has to be voted through by full council on the 6th July 2017.
