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Chairman's Report

#### **Tawstock Parish**

#### 27/09/17

One thing that has exercised our minds in the last few weeks has been the Larkbeare application for 244 houses. We had a meeting a couple of weeks ago and the item was deferred requested by the developer. However, one item that was discussed was that of the bus gate and we pressed hard for the bus gate to be removed from Gratton Way and placed into Old Torrington Road at the start of the development. This was always the plan going back to 2013.

While I have discussed waste and recycling previously and following changes at the beginning of June there was a period when bins were missed due to the fact that under the new arrangements the work force were overwhelmed. We started to get on top of this in August then hit the Bank Holiday period and once again suffered form a backlog. However, we are now hopefully on top of the situation. People were reporting that we have hundreds of complaints each week. Midway through today I asked how many complaints we had received and was advised that the number is 5 so far. However, ideally we would not want any complaints but we need to be realistic occasional a wagon will break down or a drive goes sick and when we are dealing with 90,000 collections every week we will always have some problems. What we are doing is working to mitigate these.

The Council have agreed a position visa vie new boundary areas. This does not affect Parishes only the District wards. Tawstock will remain the same at present but some houses will move into different parts of the district. Therefore you might have additional District Councillors representing you next time.
