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#### Chairman's Report

#### **Tawstock Parish Meeting**

31<sup>st</sup> Jan 2018.

First let me wish you all a belated Happy New Year. We are working up a scheme to reduce plastic in our area, both at the District Council and the wider area. There is much to do to accomplish this but ne must start somewhere.

Severn Brethren we are looking to have a masterplan crated to see how best we can manage our land assets. However, in the mean time we are pressing on with the New Leisure Centre project. We hope that following a planning the work could start in 2019.

The Council are looking to use £541,591 to purchase existing dwellings for temporary accommodation to help reduce our dependency on places like the Travel Lodge.

Much has been written about flooding and particularly with reference to the Pilton area. I have requested the Environment Agency lead on this as it is their responsibility. Further flood alleviation work will start shortly on Severn Brethren which is all part of the agreement for Anchor Bank the ASDA site.

Our District Council have reviewed the winter green waste collection process and we will ensure that green waste is collected next year during November.

I have requested our Building Control to look at the pillars outside of Tawstock Court they have been viewed and the matter has been refereed to our Heritage Officer for follow up action.
